**Mark 10:32-52**

1. Verse 32 says that those who were following Jesus were amazed and others were afraid. What is it about Jesus’ life that caused such varied responses then? Now?

2. While some were amazed at Jesus and some were fearful of Him, what were James and John thinking about? Can you identify with them?

3. Jesus’ teaching to the twelve in 42-45 seems so counter-cultural. How can we use the language of being “servant” and “slave of all” to communicate gospel truth with our lost friends?

4. According to verses 33-34, Jesus had a lot on his mind on this trip to Jerusalem. How does this last miracle in Mark (Bartimaeus) contrast with the request of James and John?
