2. How do we, as a community of faith, improve our ability to see the Risen Savior? (Heb 11:1, 1 Peter 1:8-9, 1 Cor 13:11-12, Rom 8:24-25).

3. Contrast the disciples' response to Mary in vv. 10-11 with the theme of Mark's letter? What does this contrast teach us?

4. How would you measure your own response to the revelation of Jesus' resurrection through God's living, active, and complete word?

5. After reading Mark, what are advantages we have as modern day believers that the disciples did not have? How can these advantages encourage and excite us to share the gospel as Jesus commanded in Mark 16:15?
